maximum possible.

internees at this camp as follows:

1. German internees who do not desire repatriation:

162 - total - do not desire repatriation

2. German internees who do not desire repatriation
to Germany, but desire repatriation to Central
America:

20 - adults - covered by signed request forms
14 - minors - dependents of above stated adults
34 - total - desire return to Central America

3. German internees who do not care to make a de-
cision at the present time:

32 - adults
20 - minors - dependents of above stated adults
52 - total

In compliance with your telephonic instructions of Janu-
ary 25, 1944, a list of names and signed requests was submitted to
the State Department, Alien Enemy Control Unit, and your office,
covering those cases where positive request was made for repatri-
ation to Germany. The breakdown in such group was as follows:

586 - adults - signed formal request
423 - minors - dependents of above group
1009 - desiring repatriation to Germany
