SUBJECT: Repatriation of Germans at Detention Camp,
Kenedy, Texas.

Dear Mr. Fitch:

Accompanied by Special Agent George Newkirk, I left New York on February 5, 1944 at 12:55 AM. via PRR for Washington, D. C., arriving 7:30 AM. Reported to Chief Special Agent, T. F. Fitch at 9:00 AM. We left Washington, D. C. that evening at 7:20 PM. via Eastern Airlines, San Antonio, Texas, arriving there on February 6, 1944 at 10:30 AM, when we were met by Immigration Inspector Potter, who drove us to Camp Kenedy.

Here we reported to Camp Commander, Mr. I. Williams, Assistant Camp Director, Mr. H. Adams and proceeded with the arrangements for transfer of 210 German and 65 (Reserve) Germans.

On February 8, 1944 at 6:30 PM., Custom Inspector in Charge, Mr. J. Oldham; his Assistant, W.C. DeWeese; Customs Agent, W.B. Lankford; Lieutenant John H. Crooker (in Charge); his Assistant, Lieutenant John A. Barry of the ONI; and Mr. J. O. Parker (in Charge) of the FBI arrived. On February 9, 1944 two additional FBI Agents and 17 additional Customs Inspectors including a Custom Inspectress arrived. All baggage inspection was observed by representatives of the ONI and FBI. The MIS was not in attendance at any time.

As inspection was completed, the Germans were segregated and kept incommunicado and allowed no contact with any of the other internees, nor were they permitted access to their baggage.

Left Kenedy, Texas, February 12, 1944 at noon, enroute to Jersey City, New Jersey. The 65 Germans (Reserve) were assigned to two Pullmans and attached to the rear of my train and were, according to instructions, detached at New Orleans

and

and transferred to Special Agent Geele's train, which was the second section from Crystal City. This transfer was made without incident.

Nineteen Border Patrolman under Assistant Chief Inspector, E. A. Wright, were assigned to our train.

Before leaving Kenedy, Texas, arranged for sandwiches for repatriates from Camp Commander I. Williams, due to the lack of Diner.

No breakfast was served on February 13, 1944 as the Diner was detached at Lake Charles, Louisiana. However, a substantial lunch was served when a Diner was later attached at New Orleans, Louisiana. On February 13, 1944 purchased cathartics for repatriates.

All meals enroute were signed by your Agent. Arrived at Jersey City, New Jersey, 1:30 PM., February 15. All Germans were transferred to Pier F, where they boarded the M.S. Gripsholm. This trip was made without incident.

Upon arrival at Pier F, gave Mr. R. L. Bannerman, envelopes containing 210 (Oaths not to bear Arms) Certificates of Vaccination, envelop containing personal property and papers not wanted by the U.S. Authorities, medical reports, mail and telegrams for the repatriates. Attached are two copies of receipt of acceptance of German repatriates and their luggage.

In accordance with instructions from Chief Special Agent, T. F. Fitch, proceeded to Lisbon, Portugal, aboard the M.S. Gripsholm and left Pier F, Jersey City, New Jersey, February 15, 1944 at 10:30 PM; arrived in Lisbon, Portugal, February 25, 1944 at 5:00 PM.

In port at Lisbon from February 25 to March 6 - 12:42 AM., at which time we sailed for Pier F, Jersey City, New Jersey; arrived there March 15, 1944 at 3:35 PM.

Assisted Mr. H.A. Nicholas, Passport Division from time of arrival until noon, March 17, clearing passengers aboard.
